



Off-Site Policy

On occasion Wild Explorers may venture off-site to explore the local fields and area. This will entail using the private track and farmland situated to the East of the site where access is allowed and weather permitting.

Venturing off-site will only occur if ratios of 1:5 are met, regardless of age of the children.

Children are taught road safety and will always be reminded of this when entering the private track. Staff will always be aware of any vehicles travelling either way down the track, ensuring a risk assessment has been completed before any child is allowed onto the track.

A member of staff will always be at the front of the group, one in the middle, and another at the back. Increased head counts will be taken while off-site.

- "Sticky feet" utilised whenever moving to a new area.
- First Aid Kit, work phone and children's drinks will be taken.
- If a dog approaches all children are to stand with arms crossing their bodies.
- Any interacting with strangers during the walk will always be supervised by a member of staff.
- Children will wear high vis vests
